Student Tailored Focus Area Requirements

For the Student Tailored Focus Area, you need 15 semester hours of Focus Area Electives. The Focus Area Electives selected must meet the following guidelines for a Student Tailored Focus Area:

1. The set of courses chosen must support the student's career or life plan as explained in the Career Objective Statement (see space below). The explanation must be acceptable to the CEE Curriculum Committee.
2. A non-technical Focus Area must be completed as part of a minor in that field or as part of a certificate program, and therefore each course must be part of a sequence of an increasingly challenging curriculum.
3. The set of courses chosen must demonstrate depth of learning in a particular area. An assortment of introductory courses is unacceptable.
